Riverdale inspires students to take risks, think critically, collaborate, and communicate all while creating innovative technology-infused projects that prepare them for the global community. District supported leadership teams facilitate an ongoing commitment to the use of technology and learning. Collaborative site teams support active engagement, inclusion, and innovation. These teams frequently collect data from our school community which is instrumental in furthering technology use. Collective and specialized teacher groups address challenges and promote classroom innovation. Plans are in place to refresh and sustain the 1:1 iPad program that began in 2019, which allowed us to flourish during distance learning. Our community is excited about the further development of Riverdale's Innovation Lab that will foster project-based learning.

Riverdale's core values of being empowered, innovative, and inspired are the driving forces behind providing a technology-infused Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) for our students. Students are comfortable using technology and conveying learning with their peers. They are engaged and willing to take risks by speaking in class and showcasing their work. Apple's Airplay technology empowers students to present and share work while reducing their anxiety. This practice shows ownership of their learning and increased independence. iPad enriches students' choice in publishing writing by providing flexibility and differentiation in how they demonstrate learning. Through the accessibility features on iPad, proficiency for our English Learners and Special Education population increases and fosters equity in the classroom.

As part of MTSS, a school-wide online assessment tool was adopted and integrated into our everyday practices so that a deeper understanding of students' needs are available to impact instruction. Teachers develop engaging technology-rich lessons to meet the needs and engage students on iPad. This enables personalized learning for our students to be empowered, innovative, and inspired.

100% of teachers have received Apple Teacher recognition through the Apple Teacher Learning Center. Monthly professional learning in the Apple ecosystem builds their capacity as architects of learning experiences. Since 2019, our weekly grade-level collaboration has centered around embedding technology in lessons. This provides students the space to demonstrate creative thinking and develop innovative, personal projects.



Success at Riverdale is measured by our students, teachers, and community. Students are confident in communicating clearly and expressing themselves creatively using iPad to present in multiple modalities. An example is our Riverdale News, a video broadcast collaboratively written and produced solely by students. Another part of our success is continuous feedback from our stakeholders. In our recent survey, we found:



97% of students and parents believe iPad benefits student learning and creativity.



Success is also shown through teachers' professional growth. Even with teachers at different levels of aptitude, they are confident in sharing and presenting their knowledge of how to apply and integrate technology into the classroom.
